Budding tennis stars ace board exams

Handling both their sports commitments and studies well, two city-based national-level lawn tennis players have got good results in the Class XII exams conducted by the Central Board of Secondary Education.

Both, students of DAV School, Sector 15, not only share a common name but also have the similar zeal to excel in studies as well as in sports. Digvijay Singh Naruka and Digvijay Singh Mehta secured 80 per cent and 82.6 per cent respectively in the board exams.

Naruka, a finalist in the doubles category of the

ITF (under-18), said it was hard to manage both studies and sports, but he somehow pulled it off. "The main reason I man-

aged to score well is the time management," he said. In sports too, he has been doing well. Naruka was ranked second in

India in the under-14 category in 2009. He also played for India in World Juniors (U-14) 2009.

In the School National Games 2011, Naruka bagged a gold medal, besides a silver medal in Under-19 CBSE Nationals 2011-2012.

Digvijay Singh Mehta, too, has been achieving heights in the sporting arena. He was a semifinalist in the Junior (U-14) French Open and won a bronze medal for India in the Czech Republic World Finals (U-14).

Mehta said he felt humbled by the results. "I did not put in too many hours into study, but the concentration with which I studied paid off," said Mehta.

City golfer Feroz wins Haryana Juniors tourney

CHANDIGARH: With no real threat coming from rivals, Chandigarh's Feroz Singh Garewal lifted the Haryana Juniors Golf Championship trophy (in Category A) at Golden Greens Golf Club in Gurgaon on Friday.

Garewal scored one-over-par 73 in the final round to take his four-day aggregate to three-under 285, thus defeating Kartikey Vashisby by a comfortable five-shot margin.

Manu Gahdas was third at 294, while Pirush Sangwan finished fourth at 295. The fifth and sixth positions were claimed by Viraj Madappa and Pukhraj Singh Gill, who finished with totals of 298 and 303, respectively.

Feroz began from where he had left the previous day, and parred his way on the front nine, although missing a couple of birdie opportunities.

Beginning his return journey with a bogey, the Chandigarh-lad immediately made a birdie on the very next hole. A bogey on the 13th was followed by another bogey on the 16th.

The youngster signed off with a birdie to emerge on top. "I am thrilled as all I can say," said the champion after his victory. "After the 67 in the third round, my confidence level was on a high. I just wanted to keep the ball in play and had thought of attacking only if I was challenged," the golfer added.

In Category B, another Chandigarh player, Karandeep Kochhar, had to be content with the joint-second place, after Kartik Sharma rallied from the previous day's third place to bag the top honour. Kartik shot 73 in the final round for a

four-day total of 307. Overnight joint-leaders Karandeep and Karan Sharma finished six shots behind the winner at the second place. Arjun Puri (817) was fourth, followed by Tanvir Kahlon and Jaiveer Singh, who shared the fifth place at 318.

15-yr-old city golfer claims 2nd title

LAST week, when Chandigarh golfer Feroz Singh Garewal was taking part in the IGU Juniors Golf Tournament, the 15-year-old suffered a calf sprain on the first day of the tourney. However, he continued his round and eventually finished as a runner-up in the four-day event. On Friday, Garewal added yet another feather in his cap when he claimed his second title on the IGU national junior circuit. He won the title in the IGU Haryana Juniors Golf Championship played at Golden Greens Golf Club, Gurgaon.

"The win has come at a right moment for me. I suffered a calf sprain during the Noida event last week and I was struggling with my fitness. But my father Ravi Garewal and my fitness coach told me to play my normal game and I eventually finished second. Earlier this week, I spent some time with my coach Jesse Grewal, and we worked on my swing. I was leading after the third round and it feels great to win my second title on the junior tour with a huge margin," said Garewal, who

claimed the title with an overall score of 3-under-285 and with a comfortable margin of five strokes.

The youngster had won his first title on the national junior tour in September 2011 when he claimed the title in the KGA Junior Golf Championship in Bangalore and won two tournaments at the national level after the Bangalore win before winning the Haryana juniors title.

Garewal now plans to play in the National Ama-

teur Championship's Pune leg starting later this month. "I was in a dilemma before but this win has given me

enough confidence to play at the amateur circuit. I played first at the amateur level in 2011, and playing with senior players gives me a chance to sharpen my skills. Chandigarh's Angad Cheema won the national amateur title in 2011 and most of us remember that win. Maybe we can emulate that achievement soon," said the youngster, who is a student of DAV Public School, Sector 15.

Garewal's coach Jesse Grewal is all praise for the youngster and believes that he can soon break into the Indian amateur team. "Feroz has been playing well but was finishing close second or third. This win will boost his confidence. I am sure he will soon break into the Indian amateur team in the coming years," said the coach.
