

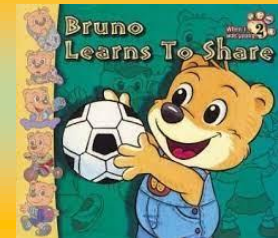

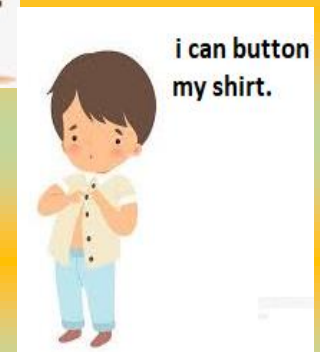

- **Vocabulary Development**

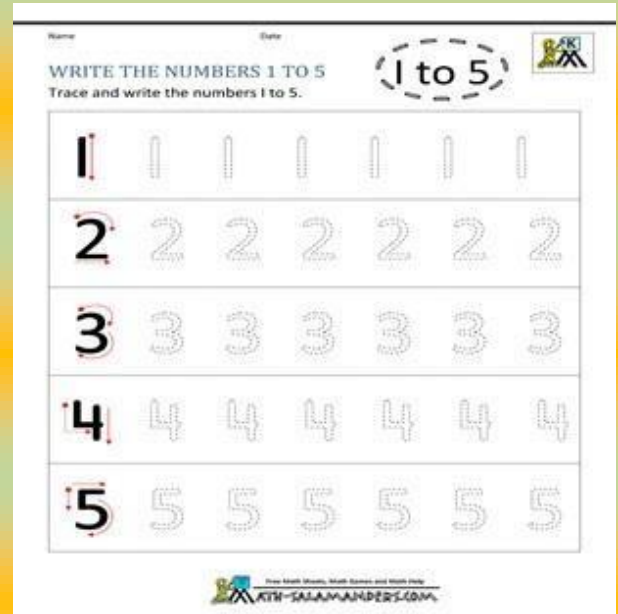
Children will be encouraged to give words beginning with a particular sound (a to z).

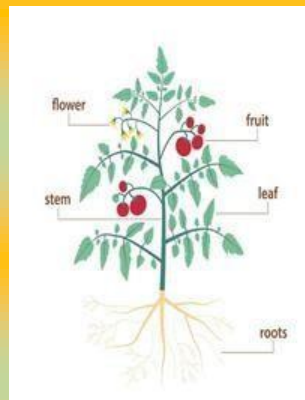
