    - Duration- 1 ½ hours

- 18.11.2019 1. E.A.D (Entertainment at D.A.V)
  - Individual Non-Competitive Activity.
  - An exciting outdoor activity that includes various fun filled games.
  - 2 (a) KAVYANJALI
    - Individual Competitive Event.
    - Students will present a poet and his/her poem in HINDI with proper actions and expressions.
    - They will be dressed in the costume of poet.
    - Four best entries will be chosen by the class teacher for which a preliminary round will be conducted on 06.11.19. No costume or prop is required for preliminary round.
    - Judgement Criteria-Poem, Costume, Presentation etc.
    - Time Limit-2-3 minutes.

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- 2 (b) CHITRON SE VYAKRAN
  - Individual Competitive Event.
    - Students will creatively depict any one concept based on Hindi Grammar. For eg. Ekvachan /Bahuvachan, Sarvnaam etc.
    - Material required- A3 size sheet, Colours, Sketch Pens etc.

1 (a) DANCE ON TUNE

- Individual Competitive Event.
- Students need to present a dance on instrumental music only. Lyrical songs are not allowed.
- Four best entries will be chosen by the class teacher for which a preliminary round will be conducted on 05.11.19. No costume or prop is required for the preliminary round.
- Judgement criteria: Synchronization, Presentation, Costume, Overall Performance.
- 1 (b) SHAPE THE SCENE
  - Individual Competitive Event.
  - Students will create a scene with <u>maximum use of any</u> <u>one basic shape on an A4 size sheet.</u>
  - Material required- A4 sheet, Colours etc.
  - Judgement criteria: Concept, Uniqueness, Creativity.
  - Duration: 1 ½ hour

Note- Students participating in 'Dance on Tune' will not participate in 'Shape the Scene'

- 2 (a) KARYASHALA -CRAFT
  - To encourage learning while doing, a workshop will be conducted by teachers.
  - Material Required:A3 Size Green Pastel Sheet, Craft Paper, Fevistick.

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### 2 (b) KARYASHALA- AEROBICS

• To motivate the students to include exercises in their daily life, a workshop on aerobics will be conducted by teachers.

20.11.2019 1 (a) LET'S RUN FOR ENGLISH

- Competitive Team Event.
- A marathon based on various concept of English Language. For example. Present Tense, Past Tense etc.
- Four students will be selected for the competition on the basis of Preliminary round which will be held on 7.11.2019.
- 1 (b) INK YOUR STORY
  - Individual Competitive Event.
  - Students will depict a story with the help of pictures.
  - Students will draw the pictures according to the sequence of the story. In English, they will write 2-3 sentences under each picture to describe the event.
  - Material Required: A-3 Size Pastel Sheet, Colours etc.
  - Judgement Criteria: Content, Sequencing, Creativity, Language and Overall Presentation.
  - Duration:  $1\frac{1}{2}$  hours.
