- (i) **Finding out your 'alarm response' or signs and symptoms of stress:** Our body produces a physical 'alarm response' that pumps adrenalin through our body, tensing our muscles and speeding up our heart. This alarm response, in most cases, does not do us any good. You can learn to respond calmly, and deal actively and positively with your stress, whether it is caused by external or internal factors.



(ii) **Identifying your physical and mental signs of stress:** It is important to identify the different signs of stress, for it could be the first step in learning how to deal with your own stress or stress signs of someone you work with such as your boss, colleague or a family member. Sometimes, you are so used to living with stress that you don't know how to identify it.

11. *What is signified by text wrapping?* [2]

Ans. Text wrapping refers to the relation of images to the surrounding text, which may wrap around the graphic on one or both sides, be overprinted behind or in front of the graphic, or treat the graphic as a separate paragraph or character.

12. *Describe the number data type in Calc in detail.* [2]

Ans. Numbers are generally raw numbers or dates. By default, number and date data is aligned to the right in Calc.

A decimal point is used as a separator for decimal numbers.

A comma is used as a separator for numerical values in thousands, one hundred thousands, etc.

Numbers can be started with a dollar sign (\$) or with some other currency symbols to display as currency.

Numbers are interpreted as a date only if it is entered in the American date format, such as mm-dd-yy: and not in the Indian format, i.e. dd-mm-yy.

13. *Explain slips, trips and falls type of accident that occur at workplace.* [2]

Ans. **Slips, trips and falls:** One of the common accidents in workplace is slipping on wet floor or you likely encountered slippery tiled surfaces. Other risks are falling from height while working, falling from stairs SLIPS TRIPS FALLS and scaffolding. These accidents can happen in any work environment and the injuries sustained can range in severity. If you were injured in the course of work as the result of a slip and fall or other type of accident, you may be entitled to financial support in the form of workers' compensation or Social Security disability.

14. *What are E-Commerce and E-Shopping?* [2]

Ans. E-Commerce is a major application of Internet. Users can buy or sell goods over the Internet by paying online using a credit card or debit card.

E-shopping is a form of electronic commerce that allows customers to directly buy goods from a seller on the Internet by using a web browser. It is also known as Online Shopping.



15. What is data inconsistency that DBMS addresses? [2]  
Ans. DBMS helps to avoid data inconsistency. It means if a single database is used by multiple users then it also ensures that the same data is present for all the users. For example, if the two departments (HR and IT) access the data simultaneously then only one department will see the updates by the other department. DBMS solves this issue.

16. What is the difference between absolute and relative links? [2]  
Ans. An absolute link will stop working only if the target is moved. A relative link will stop working only if the start and target locations change relative to each other.

17. Write the steps to create a new scenario in a spreadsheet? [4]  
Ans. To create a new scenario, follow the given steps:

- (i) Select the cells that contain the values that will change between scenarios. To select multiple ranges, hold down the **Ctrl** key as you click. You must select at least two cells.
- (ii) Choose **Tools > Scenarios**.
- (iii) On the Create Scenario dialog box, enter a name for the new scenario. It is best to use a name that clearly identifies the scenario, not the default name. This name is displayed in the Navigator and in the title bar of the border around the scenario on the sheet itself.
- (iv) Optionally add some information to the **Comment box**. This information is displayed in the Navigator when you click the Scenarios icon and select the desired scenario.
- (v) Optionally select or deselect the options in the **Settings** section.
- (vi) Click on **OK** to close the dialog. The new scenario is automatically activated.

18. What is a template? Write the steps to create a document from Templates dialog box. [4]  
Ans. A template is a document model that you use to create other documents. For example, you can create a template for business reports that has your company's logo on the first page. New documents created from this template will all have your company's logo on the first page.

Templates can contain anything that regular documents can contain, such as text, graphics, a set of styles, and user-specific setup information such as measurement units, language, the default printer, and toolbar and menu customization.

Using template to create a document, follow the given steps:

- (i) From the menu bar, choose **File > New > Templates**, or click on the small arrow next to the New icon on the Standard toolbar and select Templates.
- (ii) From the Filters list at the top of the **Templates** dialog, optionally select a **Category**.
- (iii) Find and double-click on the required template. A new document based on the selected template opens in Writer. You can then edit and save the new document just as you would in any other document.

19. Explain the different types of network topologies. [4]

Ans. (i) **Mesh Topology**: In mesh topology, each computer is connected to every other computer to provide an alternate path for transferring data.

(ii) **Star Topology**: In a star topology, each computer is connected to a centrally located device called hub.

(iii) **Bus Topology**: In a bus topology, one long cable acts as a backbone to link all the computers in a network.

(iv) **Ring Topology**: In a ring topology, each computer is connected with the two computers on either side of it.

20. What happens when you apply prevent changes to a scenario enabled as a copy back? [4]  
 Ans. This prevents changes to a scenario enabled as a copy back, when the sheet is protected but the cells are not. It also prevents changes to the settings described while the sheet is protected.
