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ANNUAL REPORT 2020-21

The academic session 2020-21 commenced under the guidance of the DAV management from 26th March 2020 for classes X and XII and on 3rd April, 2020 for other classes amidst the lockdown due to COVID 19. The syllabus to be covered along with the lesson plan and the time table was framed online keeping in mind the physical and mental well-being of the students, without overburdening them.

One activity period along with other three subjects were scheduled every day. WhatsApp group of students of each class was created. The study material in the form of zoom and Google sessions, Audio, Video, PPTs, Podcasts, YouTube links, hand written notes and images was first scrutinized before forwarding to the students on WhatsApp group at the assigned time on working days. From June the major teaching platform Microsoft Teams was used. The online Times NIE, Hindustan Times, and The Hindu newspaper were shared with the students.

The study material and training session by the DAV Centre for Academic Excellence was instrumental in such trying times. Teachers underwent a variety of training from CBSE, Diksha, Sahodaya and other regulatory bodies and kept themselves updated. The IT teachers and assistance provided enough training for us Microsoft Teams platform.

The school counselor and special educator designed special sessions for children with special needs they periodically checked and supervised and ensured that the student achieved the desired results.

To achieve desired results, tests were conducted online. The answer keys were forwarded and the parents were urged to help in this online-teaching learning process by providing the required atmosphere and guidance to the students. The students were also allotted life skill based holiday assignments during their break. The parents were appreciative and said that it was an effective way of moving ahead undeterred in such times of crisis.

Environmental week was celebrated. Science Exhibition was conducted through the online forum for Std. V to XII with various topics classwise to engage and keep scientific temperament and curiosity amongst students.

Parent teachers meeting and open houses were conducted online as well as offiline to update the parents with students performance.

School received support from the Management Committee and PTA members especially during these trying times.

Though we could reach the students at home, virtually and they could study at their own pace, they missed the interaction, the teachers, the classrooms and the school! Yet we cannot undermine the efficacy of this session and hope the situation improves for better.
